It will be held at the "Golden Trout pack station" from 1:00pm through 5:pm. On Sept 4 Sunday of Labor Day weekend. There will be food, and Pattie Tori will be singing Barbie's favorite songs. Rinda 559-542-2816 of the pack station is organizing this for me. I've provided many pictures, poems and Barbie's Tee Pee that she so much enjoyed seeing put up. Our life together was a fairy tale by most standards. I would love the people who knew her to hear about her passions in life and the way she lived it here on earth and her passing on to her everlasting life. I'm looking forword to being with all that loved my beloved Barbie.

It's been a long hard three months for me since Barbie passed March 25 on Good Friday morning. I've been traveling in our RV from one friend's arms into another throughout the US. I'm on my way to Michigan Tech University where I received my Bachelor degree in Mechanical engineering. We started a scholarship fund for future Mechanical engineers that need financial help. Since Barbie and I had not had children, we decided years ago to support students that we both feel is a way of bettering our world long after we both have left this beautiful planet. I will then travel to the Chicago area to be with my sister and nieces for my 70th birthday. From there I'll travel back west, stopping at a few more friends that were an important part of Barbie's final days. I hope to be back in Ponderosa by mid-August. 


