#### USFS SUPPORTS PONDEROSA FIRE BRIGADE

A big thanks goes out to Jesse Sanchez Capt. 23 for his generous donation of 3 wet water bags and some nozzles for the Ponderosa Fire Brigade! These will help with the new patrols in the Peppermint and Quaking Aspen Campgrounds. Captain Sanchez has been very supportive of the brigade and has participated in our training program. His team helped our members hone their skills at hose lays as well as nozzle work! Their demonstrations were amazing and appreciated by all of the brigade members.

#### PONDEROSA FIRE BRIGADE COVERS PEPPERMINT AND QUAKING ASPEN CAMPGROUNDS

Peppermint Campground as well as Quaking Aspen Campground are within the current jurisdiction of the Ponderosa Fire Brigade. As we all know, there is no water source (Hydrants) in either of these areas and therefore, we must rely on the Fire Truck for any fire suppression that becomes necessary. The truck has 250 gallons of water on board as well as several wet water bags and fire extinguishers.

Due to the discovery of some camp fires left unattended at the end of the weekends this summer, the Brigade began patrolling both these campgrounds. Every Sunday between 4 – 6 pm we drove through to ensure no fires were present. A big thank you goes out to Jim Parminter, Wes Pabst, Dana Stewart, Tammi Stewart, Dee Graham and Kurt Rhea for their participation on these added patrols. #### Sierra Skies

Fall is here and winter is on the way. One great thing about being in the high Sierras during winter is the great displays in the night sky. Some of the most striking constellations make their appearances during this time of year. If there is a downside to winter nights in the Sierras, it may that the skies are so dark and there are so many bright stars it can be hard to find your way around them! Fortunately, there are some really good sites on the internet to help you out.

One great site is Sky and Telescope. The link <a href="http://www.skyandtelescope.com/astronomy-resources/stargazing-basics/learn-the-sky/">http://www.skyandtelescope.com/astronomy-resources/stargazing-basics/learn-the-sky/</a> will take you to a "beginner's" page. Starting in the first paragraph, there's a link to a page to help you build your own star chart. Dig a little deeper and find the video that shows you how to use it. Search for "winter asterisms" and get a walk-through of the winter sky. Look under the "Observing" link in the top banner and click on "For Beginners" for much more.

If you've done this a while and are beyond the beginner stage, hang in there because there's more to explore here. There is an equipment guide, news on space missions, a multimedia page and much, much more on this site.

Another great thing about winter nights in the Sierras is that, when you're done looking at the stars, the hot chocolate tastes really good!


